At the Asset & Highways meeting on the 18th July 2022, the committee considered the quotes received for the replacement of Finche Field steps and agreed a contractor for recommendation to council. (Quotation sent to councillors via email) If agreed the A&H committee propose that the works take place during October half term to minimise the disruption to families travelling to school.

The clerk has been in contact with WSCC regarding the footpath closure and they have agreed to waive any fees.

Item 15

Jenny at Worth PC has reported that after a lot of to-ing and fro-ing, the only way that the Cluster SID can be written off is for Evolis to see it. This would entail sending it back to France, Alan from Evolis says that this will cost £500+ in shipping alone. He has offered to supply a replacement unit at a discounted price of £2,000.

The replacement would cost approximately £400 per council, subject to how many councils agree to contribute and minus any eligible funding.
