### **Asset and Highways Committee Clerks Report March 2023**

#### **Actions taken and other points of information since last meeting.**

- The new grit bin has been delivered to the Village Hall and is awaiting installation.
- Following a review of the grit/salt supplies, the handman reported that most of the bins in the parish were empty or very near empty and that there were limited stores available at Hook Farm. Recognising the increased usage of grit this year due to the cold weather, WSCC put in place a onetime offer for additional supplies, through collection from their depot- many thanks to Cllr Martin Robinson for agreeing to collect additional supplies for the parish, which he then distributed to the bins, with the assistance of the council handman.
- The application to release S106 funds to purchase the portable SID device was approved by MSDC. The clerk has begun the process to purchase the SID
- The Parish Tidy Day will take place on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2023, 9:30am meet at Finche Field, please encourage residents to attend.
