113) To receive apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Cllr Amy Marshall, Cllr Sinead Young and Cllr Bob Darvill

114) To receive declarations of interest from Councillors in respect of any matter on the Agenda

There were none

115) To approve minutes of the Meeting of the Asset & Highways Committee held on 15th July 2024 (Document Reference 2414)

An amendment was made to minute 80 to read - It was noted that the SID has now been deployed continuously since October 2023 and has been rotated around the agreed locations, which included 6 weeks in Highbrook. The 4th bracket has also now been installed. Cllr Paul Brown advised that he intends to complete another data download soon.

116) To receive the clerk's report and note any points of interest

The Clerks report was received.

117) To review expenditure against budget for the year to 17th September 2024

The expenditure was noted.

Assets

118) To receive report on Finche Field & the Allotments

a) To receive an update on the Vinols Cross planter competition

No entries have been received; it was agreed to promote the competition further in the Chronicle. Committee to consider alternative solutions at the next meeting when discussing the budget for 2024-25.

119) To receive report on North Lane Recreation Ground

a) To receive an update on the work to replace the handwashing facilities at the public conveniences

The Clerk provided an update, it was agreed to go ahead with removing the Wallgate machines and replacing them with stainless steel basins with percussion taps and hand dryers.

120) To receive the Arboricultural report and agree next steps

It was noted that the report had not been received in time for the meeting.

Highways

121) To receive an item of correspondence from a resident regarding safety concerns on Ardingly Road

The item of correspondence was discussed, it was agreed that a Community Highways Scheme application as suggested by the County Councillor, is unlikely to be successful. Clerk to share WSCC Speed Limit Policy with resident.

122) To note issues on parish footpaths and bridleways

a) To receive an update on FP23WH and agree next steps

It was noted that the WSCC Local Access Ranger has asked that the resurfacing of FP23WH be considered within the capital program. The application will compete for funding against other requests for footpath improvements across West Sussex.

Following discussion, it was agreed that the Clerk will contact the Rights of Way Team to request permission to use sandstone chippings to cover the worst affected areas. If agreed, this work will be funded by WHPC.

Cllr Martin Robinson enquired whether there is a minimum gap for pedestrians on a public footpath. Cllr Claire Hilton agreed to have a look at FP26_1WH and advise.

123) To receive a report on SID deployment

Cllr Paul Brown provided several reports, which were circulated to councillors via email, prior to the meeting. Cllr Brown gave an overview of the data and answered questions from committee members.

124) To consider the newly painted centre lines in Top Road, Sharpthorne

It was noted that the centre lines in Top Road, Sharpthorne and the edge lines in The Hollow, West Hoathly have been reinstated without prior consultation with the Parish Council. The committee queried whether these changes comply with the markings of the C319 within the limits of the 30 mph TRO previously agreed by WSCC Highways dept. This included the highlighted junction boxes at Broadfield, North Lane, Vinols Cross and Station Road with road markings minimised to emphasise the 30mph zone. Clerk will follow up with WSCC Highways Area Manager.

General

125) To receive an update on the Finche Field Management Plan following the meeting on the 21st September

The working group meeting on the 21st September did not go ahead due to unavailability of working group members. Cllr Brown had drafted up the main points of agreement at the previous working group meetings and tabled paper copies to those present for consideration prior to and at the next meeting of the A&H committee.

126) To review the Local Winter Management Plan

The latest edition of the Local Winter Management Plan prepared by WSCC was reviewed. It was agreed to remove the section that says 'Mr Paul Brown has agreed to clear the footway from the junction of Top Road and Church Hill down to opposite Bulldogs Bank' Cllr Paul Brown was thanked for agreeing to clear the footway for several years.

127) To note any correspondence received

The items of correspondence were noted.
